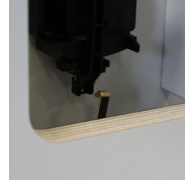


REPLACING A KLOQ'S PENDULUM AND HANDS.

Make sure to replace the hands and pendulum in a well-lit area.

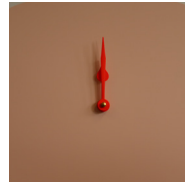

First of all, replace the pendulum. This is hooked onto the arm of the timepiece at the back of the KLOQ. Remove it by pulling the pendulum up and back. Hang the new pendulum on the arm.

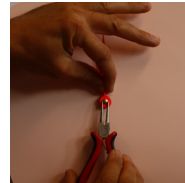
First set the KLOQ to 12:00. Make sure that both hands are pointing up exactly the same.

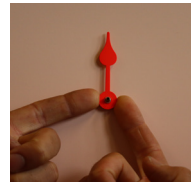
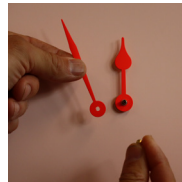
Carefully hold both clock hands with two fingers so that they cannot move and unscrew the cap screw from the hands with small pliers or your fingers. Turn left.

Pay attention! This one can be fitted very tight. Also, be careful not to damage the hands with the pliers.

Carefully pull the big hand towards you in one vertical movement to remove it. The small hand is attached a little more tight, but you can also remove it in the same direction. *Make sure that you gently pull on the lower, sturdy round part of the hands and not on the fragile long part.*

When the hands are removed, you can put the new hands back in the same way, pointing up at 12:00.

First you press the small hand around the plastic part of the shaft and then place the large hand on top.

Now replace the cap screw and tighten it firmly to the right. It is preferable to use small pliers that cannot damage the hands. Hold both the clock hands as you do this.
